Event Rules/Guide to Showing

- On entry to the premises you agree to abide by the rules detailed below. All dogs are entered at this show at their owners' risk, and whilst every care will be taken, the European Plummer Terrier Society will accept no responsibility for loss, damage or injury, however caused, to dogs, persons or property whilst attending this event.
- The rules (as detailed) will be strictly enforced by the chief steward, committee or their agent/assignees; this is accepted by individuals upon entrance to the premises. The committee reserves the right to make bye laws with immediate affect.
- All persons agree to abide by the rules detailed at all times whilst in attendance.
- The committee, stewards and judge reserve the right to refuse entry.
- Parents are responsible for the behavior/safety of their children (under 18 years of age).
- An adult must accompany all children under the age of 12 at all times.
- No smoking or consumption of drugs or alcohol in or around the show ring.
- The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is forbidden.
- Dog Fouling: Owners are responsible for clearing up after their dogs.
- All dogs must be kept on leads within the confines of the show.
- Dogs must be fully inoculated.
- No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
- The term 'Handler' refers to the competitor and does not have to be the owner.
- It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that their dog is eligible for the class that they have entered.
- A smart casual dress code will apply.
- In the event of cancellation/abandonment the Committee reserves the right to defray from the entries any such expenses as they deem necessary.
- The standard detailed by the European Plummer Terrier Society will be utilised by the judge at all times.
- Dogs entered must be registered with the EPTR, and must provide supporting documents if asked to within 1 week of the show ,
- With regards to the placement of entrants the judge's decision is final.
- Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the Judge, may alter arrangements as necessary.
- Should a judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge, the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
- No other breeds or breed types to be brought onto the premises.
- Hunting or fishing will not be permitted.
- No open fires with the exception of barbecues OFF THE GROUND .
- No litter should be left behind.
- Attendants must stay within the perimeter of the grounds.
- Noise pollution after 23.30HR will not be accepted.
- The show organisers reserve the right to add bye laws as appropriate.
